Applications Now Available for Community Development Block Grants

The deadline to submit applications for the City of Banning's Fiscal Year 2022-2023

Community Development Block Grants is Monday, October 25, 2021, by 4:00 P.M.

Banning, CA – On September 14, 2021, the City of Banning received a Notice of Funding Available for the County of Riverside's 2022-2023 Urban County Community Development Block grant program for Cooperating Cities and is now accepting applications.

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), through Riverside County Housing, Homelessness Prevention and Workforce Solutions administers the CDBG funding. The funding will allow the community the opportunity to provide services within the City of Banning.

Eligible public services include but are not limited to:

- Healthcare
- Job training
- Childcare
- Services for the homeless
- Recreation programs
- Services for seniors
- Public safety services

Organizations must apply to the City of Banning in hard copy only, to be considered for a sub-recipient award. Applications can be found on the city's website at www.banningca.gov and are available at City Hall at the Information desk. Applications will be reviewed by an appointed ad-hoc committee and submitted to City Council for approval on November 9, 2021, at the Regular Meeting scheduled for 5:00 pm at 99 East Ramsey Street, Banning, CA 92220.

Applications are due no later than 4:00 p.m. on Monday, October 25, 2021, Applications will be accepted at Banning City Hall – Economic Development Department.
